

# Safety Moment



- **What happened:** An employee of a company used an Instant Hand Sanitizer available in the bathroom. He immediately went outside for a cigarette break. It was windy so he held his hand up to block the wind as he was lighting the cigarette his hand burst into flames as he had not fully rubbed in the sanitizer.
