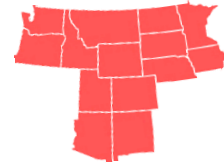

SUBJECT: First and Second-Year Leadership School

First and Second Year Leadership Schools for 2022 will be held at the University of Iowa in Iowa City the week of September 26, 2022. Classes will be limited to a maximum of 75 participants with a minimum of 30 participants required for classes to be held.

Leadership School is a five-day residential program for local leaders which provides in-depth training by university staff, with assistance from CWA. Local Officers, Executive Board Members, Stewards, and Committee Members who have completed CWA Steward's Training are eligible to participate in the First Year School. In addition to these qualifications, participants of the Second Year School must have attended First Year School.

Housing is provided at the Iowa House Hotel, a non-smoking establishment. ***This year we have a limited number of sleeping rooms and ask participants to double up, if possible.*** Please indicate on your application if you are willing to share a room. Once we have received the registrations, we will give those who volunteer to share rooms a \$100 break on the tuition.

The cost of some meals is included in the program tuition. These include the Sunday evening banquet and the graduation lunch on Friday and meal tickets for breakfast (\$9.00) and lunch (\$10.00), Monday through Thursday. Other expenses, including dinners with the exception of Sunday evening, transportation and personal charges at the Iowa House, must be paid by the conference participant.

The tuition for each student is \$1100. District 7's Lumen bargaining unit has a negotiated tuition aid program known as Partners in Education that will pay for this program. All PIE participants will need to bring any paperwork including letter of credit, etc. to the class. (AT&T tuition assistance does NOT pay for these classes.)

District 7 will provide a few scholarships for applicants who are not eligible for tuition assistance through their employer. The scholarships will be for tuition only; they will not include transportation, lost time or incidental meal expenses. If you are interested in a scholarship, please indicate so when completing your application. Scholarship applicants will be asked to share rooms and should submit their applications by July 28, 2022.
